Social Venture Partners Boulder County (SVP) engages donors, community members and nonprofits to work side-by-side. We help individuals make a greater impact with their giving and volunteering, strengthen and fund nonprofits, and equip our community to tackle our greatest social challenges – together. Started in 2000, we’ve supported 23 Boulder County non-profits with grants of over \$1.2 million in cash, and \$1.8 million in pro bono management consulting and education. We offer educational opportunities for local non-profits, their staff and volunteers through three instructor-led series, board-member workshops, how-to white papers, an online ‘Ask an Expert’ Q&A, and more.
