## NONPROFITS



SVP's programming for nonprofits includes capacity building support (training, leadership development, and consulting) that strengthens organizations so they can better deliver on their missions.

### **BOARD GOVERNANCE TRAINING – BOARDS WITH BRAINS**

Leadership knowledge and skill building covering a breadth of governance topics. Crafted for current and future Board members; open to anyone.

### **EXECUTIVE COACHING – EXECES EVOLVE**

Quality one-on-one executive coaching that builds better leaders. [Paired with training on coaching techniques and skills for SVP Partner members.]

### **PEER LEARNING COHORTS – INVESTED LEADERS**

Facilitated peer learning and networking sessions to strengthen the leadership skills of nonprofit executives and Board chairs.

### **ORGANIZATIONAL ASSESSMENTS – PIVOT POINTS**

Facilitated self-assessment on the current state of an organization's business functions, resulting in consensus on priorities. [Paired with assessment and facilitation training for SVP Partner members.]

### **MULTI-YEAR CONSULTING INVESTMENTS – CATAPULT**

Three-and-a-half-year strategic investments of consulting, education, and mentoring supported by cash grants. [Paired with training in skills and knowledge for SVP Partner members.]
