We are looking to provide resources for the **next 5 weeks**. 125 families rely on United Indians of All Tribes Foundation (UIATF) for supplemental food and living basics. We currently have the capacity to fund 1/3 of that need. You can close the gap.

Packages with non-perishable food and other necessities will be made for families in our preschool, our Elders, residents of our Labateyah Youth Home, and many of our other clients.
