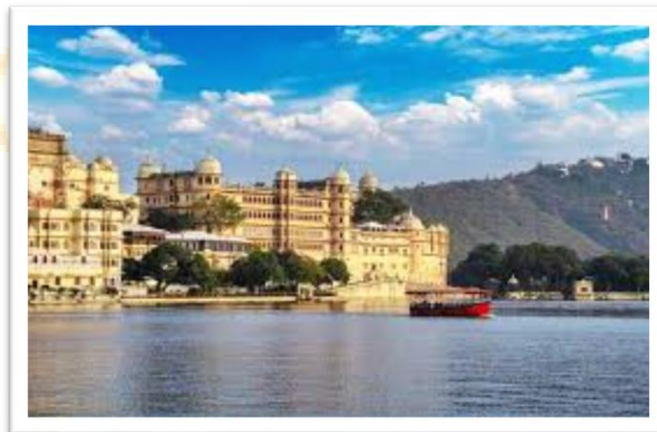

## **Day 01          Arrival Jaipur (Arrival Transfer only)**

Meet and greet at Jaipur Airport on arrival. Transfer to Hotel Check in and Day at Leisure to acclimatize OR . Evening take a stroll in the markets of Jaipur for the traditional dresses and shoes, curio shops, blue pottery etc. Overnight stay in Jaipur.

## **Day 2          Jaipur Sightseeing**

After breakfast, proceed for full-day sightseeing trip of Jaipur, also known as the 'Pink City'. Visit the Amber Fort. The best way to explore the fort is to ride up to it on Elephant back. Prominent structures inside the fort are the Diwan-i-Aam, adorned with latticed galleries, the Ganesh Pol, with a beautiful painted image of Lord Ganesh, and the stunning Sheesh Mahal, a hall decorated with thousands of tiny mirrors. En route drive past and photo stop at the beautiful Hawa Mahal, also known as the "Palace of the Winds.". Lastly, visit the Jantar Mantar Observatory, comprising geometric devices for measuring time, and tracking stars in their orbits and the Albert Hall Museum. Post that drive back to hotel Overnight in Jaipur.

## **Day 3          Jaipur - Jodhpur (330 kms / Approx.7 hrs)**

After breakfast proceed to Jodhpur which is the second largest city in Rajasthan and also called the 'Sun City'. Upon arrival check-in to your hotel. Enjoy rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay in Jodhpur.

## **Day 4          Jodhpur Sightseeing**

After breakfast proceed for half day sightseeing trip of Jodhpur, Visit the Mehrangarh Fort. This spectacular fort made from red sandstone stands on a perpendicular cliff above the skyline of Jodhpur. Also visit Jaswant Thada, a marble cenotaph built to commemorate Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. The monument, in its entirety, is built out of intricately carved sheets of marble. Later, drive past the Mandore garden, which showcases cenotaphs of Jodhpur's former rulers; instead of the usual umbrella-shaped cenotaphs these are built along the lines of a Hindu temple. Later Visit the Umaid bhawan Museum. Post lunch proceed towards Osian Desert Camp for a memorable desert experience. Upon arrival, enjoy camel ride through the golden desert landscape. The experience continues with engaging cultural performances showcasing local folk music and dance. The evening concludes with a dinner at the desert camp, offering an authentic Rajasthani ambiance before returning to the hotel for an overnight stay in Jodhpur.

## **Day 5          Jodhpur - Ranakpur - Udaipur (270 kms / Approx.6 hrs)**

After breakfast, proceed to Udaipur. Enroute, visit the Ranakpur Temples, acclaimed worldwide for their intricate and superb architectural style. These temples form one of the five major pilgrimages of the Jain's. Arrive Udaipur and check in to your hotel and relax.. Overnight in Udaipur

## **Day 6          Udaipur Sightseeing**

After breakfast, proceed for full-day tour of Udaipur. Visit the City Palace, standing on the east bank of Lake Pichola. The complex is a massive series of palaces built at different times from 1559. The balconies of the palace provide panoramic views of the Lake Palace Hotel and Jag Mandir on one side, and the city of Udaipur on the other. Thereafter, visit a picturesque garden, Sahelion ki Bari. You will visit also visit Jagdish Temple, which is raised on a tall terrace and was completed in 1651. It attaches a double-storey Mandapa (hall) to a double-storey saandhara (with a covered ambulatory) sanctum. In the evening, enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola which is an artificial fresh water lake, created in the year 1362 AD. Overnight stay in Udaipur.

## **Day 7          Udaipur Departure (Departure Transfer only)**

Today after breakfast, transfer to Udaipur airport for flight back home.
